

MINUTES OF LEE & LINCOMBE RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION MEETING HELD ON

- 1). Apologies were received from Alan Bannister and Karen Crutchfield.
- 2). Minutes of the last Meeting approved and signed.
- 3). No Matters Arising.
- 4). Eric welcomed Pat Coates and Paul Scarrott our new co-opted members.
- 5). Election of Officers.

Carolyn would like to stand down as Secretary but Paul Thom and Eric Couling agree to continue as Treasurer and Chairman. Paul Scarrott agreed to become Secretary, this was proposed by Paul Thom and seconded by Elizabeth Gilliat and carried. Eric as Chairman proposed by Paul Thom and seconded by Mavis Rogers and carried. Paul Thom as Treasurer proposed by Eric Couling and seconded by Elizabeth and carried. The Committee thanked Carolyn for her work as Secretary.

- 6). Treasurers Report. Finances have not changed, but Committee members do need to chase up subscriptions. Paul reported that we have 6 signatories on the L.L.R.A account and this was felt to be enough.
- 7). Lee Bay Hotel planning application.

The Committee discussed the new application in depth. A letter with our observations needs to be no later than 13th July. It was decided Trevor Greaves would draught a letter, to be circulated to the Committee for their comments or approval. The Committee voted on the plans, six members opposed and two abstained. As the Fuchsia List will not allow a comment on the planning application to appear on the list, it was suggested a link be put from the Fuchsia List to the L.L.R.A website.

- 8). Any Other Business.

Elizabeth Gilliat requested a letter be sent to I.T.C. Asking the owners of Lee Bay Hotel to improve the appearance of the site before the summer season. There is evidence of purposeful neglect of the site. Paul Scarrott as new Secretary will write to Council.

There have been objections to the siting and size of the new lifebouy in the Bay. We have been informed that the site was chosen as it is Council land and the size is due to it being in a cabinet for health and safety reasons.
